Ingredients

Soybean Meal, Ground Corn, Wheat Bran, Wheat Flour, Calcium Carbonate, Dried Whey, Mono-Dicalcium Phosphate, Fish Meal, Dried Distillers Corn Solubles with Grains, Canola Oil, Salt (Sodium Chloride), Choline Chloride, Propionic Acid (a preservative), Zinc Oxide, Manganous Oxide, Ferrous Sulfate, Vitamin A Acetate, Vitamin E (Alpha Tocopherol), Vitamin D3 Supplement, DL-Calcium Pantothenic Acid, Riboflavin Supplement, Niacin Supplement, Vitamin K (Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex), Thiamine Mononitrate, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Copper Sulfate, Ethylenediamine Dihydriodide, Vitamin B12 Supplement, Folic Acid, Biotin Supplement, Sodium Selenite (Selenium).



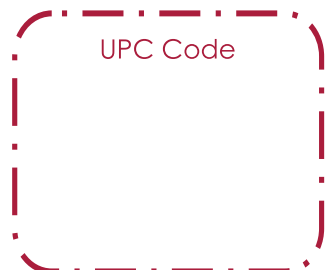

Feeding Directions

For Turkeys — Feed GB/Turkey Starter continuously as a sole diet to turkey poults from 0 to 6 weeks of age. From 6 to 12 weeks, feed Gamebird/Turkey Developer. After 12 weeks, feed Gamebird/Turkey Breeder.

For Gamebirds — Feed GB/Turkey Starter continuously as a sole diet from 0 to 8 weeks of age. After 8 weeks, transition to the Gamebird/Turkey Developer For meat birds, continue free-feeding Developer until ready for market. For release, transition to Gamebird/Turkey Breeder at 11 weeks, and free-feed until release. For breeding, transition to Gamebird/Turkey Breeder at 14 weeks. During breeding season, feed Gamebird/Turkey Starter.

Store in a cool, dry, ventilated location away from rodents and insects. Do not feed if moldy, spoiled, insect /rodent infested, or if feed has an uncharacteristic odor or appearance, as it may cause illness or death. WARNING! - Do not feed to sheep. This feed contains added copper at levels that may be toxic if consumed by sheep.
