## Ingredients

Steam Rolled Barley, Steam Rolled Corn, Steam Rolled Milo, Cane Molasses, Soybean Meal, Wheat Bran, Ascorbic Acid, Mono-Dicalcium Phosphate, Calcium Carbonate, Salt (Sodium Chloride), Phosphoric Acid, L-Lysine Hydrochloride, Hydrolyzed Vegetable Oil, Propionic Acid (a preservative), Potassium Chloride), Choline Chloride, Vitamin A Acetate, Vitamin D3 Supplement, Vitamin E (Alpha Tocopheryl), Magnesium Oxide, Manganous Oxide, Calcium Iodate, Riboflavin Supplement, Niacin Supplement, Zinc Oxide, Vitamin K (Menadione Dimethylpyrimidinol Bisulfite), Folic Acid, DL-Calcium Pantothenic Acid, Thiamine Mononitrate, Ferrous Sulfate, Copper Oxide, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Vitamin B12 Supplement, Cobalt Carbonate, Sodium Selenite (Selenium).

## **Feeding Directions**

Dairy cattle can be fed 9 lbs. of Dairy Feed twice a day during milking in addition to good quality alfalfa hay. Amount of grains should be based on size of cow, body conditioning, and pounds of milk being produced. The grain portion should make up about 1% to 1.5% body weight or 1/2 pound of grain for each pound of milk. Make sure cattle have plenty of water since they drink about 15 gallons per day. A salt block or loose trace mineral salt should also be available at all times.

Store in a cool, dry, ventilated location away from rodents and insects. Do not feed if moldy, spoiled, insect/rodent infested, or if feed has an uncharacteristic odor or appearance, as it may cause illness or death. WARNING! - Do not feed to sheep. This feed contains added copper at levels that may be toxic if consumed by sheep.
