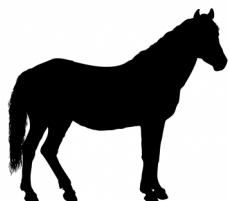




Hay Replacer Pellets



A 3/8 inch, alfalfa based pellet with added molasses, vitamins, and minerals.



Guaranteed Analysis

Crude Protein	- not less than 11.0%
Crude Fat	- not less than 1.0%
Crude Fiber	- not more than 32.0%

Ingredients

Alfalfa Hay, Bermuda Grass with Mixed Grasses, Cane Molasses, Salt (Sodium Chloride), Choline Chloride, Vitamin C-Coated Ascorbic Acid, Phosphoric Acid, Manganous Oxide, Magnesium Oxide, Calcium Iodate, Zinc Oxide, Niacin Supplement, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin E (Alpha Tocopherol), Vitamin K (Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex), Folic Acid, Calcium Pantothenate, Thiamine Mononitrate, Ferrous Sulfate, Copper Oxide, Riboflavin Supplement, Cobalt Carbonate, Vitamin D3 Supplement, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Vitamin B12 Supplement, Sodium Selenite (Selenium).

Feeding Directions

Hay pellets are a good feeding option for older horses, horses with bad teeth who have trouble chewing, or horses who are sensitive to breathing in dust from long-stem hay. It is recommended that hay pellets should not exceed more than 50% of the horse's total forage portion of the diet. The minimum forage intake for most adult horses is 1.5—2.0% of their total body weight per day. Make all feeding changes gradually.

Provide clean, fresh drinking water at all times. Store in a cool, dry, ventilated location away from rodents and insects. Do not feed if moldy, spoiled, insect/rodent infested, or if feed has an uncharacteristic odor or appearance, as it may cause illness or death. WARNING! Do not feed to sheep. This feed contains added copper at levels that may be toxic if consumed by sheep.
